Our training coordinator was at this meeting and handed out packets which included guidelines and information for panel leaders and prospective panel leaders. These packets are available for anyone wishing to do H&I service. See Gary D. or me about that.

It is proving difficult to build the Committee back up to anywhere near the numbers that it used to enjoy. I suspect that there are a number of factors that are contributing to this: One is the general decline in membership in the fellowship in much of this area over the last 10 years or so, another is probably the fact that this committee has had some problems recovering from the effects of the pandemic, these may have been compounded by my own lack of experience when I first began chairing the committee. However, I feel that the primary factor is an attitude of indifference towards doing service. This is a problem, I suspect, not only for this committee but for our Area and our Region. I can't speak for Areas and Regions outside our own. I don't know quite what to do about this. We've tried announcing that the Committee needs support, we've tried a flier that should have been effective. Our 11th Tradition discourages attraction, so billboards or radio ads are out, but I would certainly welcome any other suggestions. One thing that occurs to me is that we should be encouraging newcomers to get involved while they're still eager. They may not meet the requirements to speak, let alone be a panel leader, but they can begin fulfilling the requirements and they can get involved and by the time they have the clean time requirements met they will be ready to go into service. So, please take this back to your meetings and let's see what we can do.


