HELPLINE CHAIRPERSON REPORT – Reine A.

From 1/26/23 to2/22/23, the Helpline received one voice message which I returned, It was from a women that had a son using Heroin in NYC. The helpline also received 12 incoming calls, which 2 were from me and 3 outgoing calls. It looks to me as if we have a credit still of 49.35. Since Nov, Ninja began charging us 20.00 a month. Prior to this, it was 9.95 a month. I have been calling Ninja and speaking to a person who gives me a ticket number and says that someone will call me back and no one has called me back. I have emailed the support number numerous times and no one emails me back. I had called Eric, the previous Helpline Chair and he has tried to get in touch and no one has called him back. After being very frustrated with all this and not being able to communicate with anyone at this company. I called the ABCD Helpline number because I wanted to see how that was running. It was very easy system. It asks you to choose number 1 if you want to speak to a volunteer or choose number 2 if you want a list of meetings. I chose number 2 and it asks if you want a meeting list by zip code or city. I called twice of course and tried both ways: They gave me a list of meetings in MHA and also texted me the 5 meetings to my phone. I then called the ABCD Helpline Chair Cassie. She told me that our area is on their Helpline, and its no cost to us. They pay for it as the region. She also said that when you push 2 for a meeting, it will give you the meetings that are coming up close to the time that you called. So if you called at 12 noon. It will give you a list of meetings coming up after noon. She said that I can ask for volunteers that are already on our Helpline or anyone else if they would like to be a volunteer. The volunteer is only to speak to an addict that needs to talk. She said most of their calls are for meetings. We would be a sub committee. I would attend the sub committee meetings. She just asked that any changes to our meeting list be updated with the Region, which I am sure Christine is already doing. I know that our current Helpline also has a space for someone to leave a message for PR and H & I, Since I took over in Oct, there has only been 1 call to

So going forward, I feel that it would be prudent for our area and will also promote unity to join in with the ABCD region Helpline, which again, we are already a part of and is to no cost to us. I will work on talking to our volunteers and others if they are interested. The Helpline number would need to be changed on our literature. I will speak to the meeting list chair about that. Like I said, we still have 49.35 credit with Ninja, which can run out by the time we get this all going.
