- The Message is Hope (Christine S.). Meeting is going great. Carol G. will celebrate her first Miracle year on 3/2/24.
- Based on the Evidence 2 (Royal for Kathy M.). \$50 contribution to Area tonight. We have 30-40 people attend each week, 6 people in the business meeting. Rotating format, literature based meeting, bring your NA approved literature. All is well, meeting maintains atmosphere of recovery.
- Peak of Serenity (Lavonna). We have 5 group members. Isiah will celebrate his first year on 3/12!
- Hope in Hudson (Ryan R.). Meeting is doing well. Attendance has been good and we got a new home group member this month.
- Last Chance (Eric). Attendance has been consistent, small good. Eric celebrates 17 years on 3/3!
- Keep Hope Alive (Cristy M.). Group needs support! Rotating format, average 6-8 attendees with 2-3 group members. Looking for support and visibility. *Note: This meeting is new to our Area and it meets Mondays from 7:30-8:30 at Zion Episcopal Church, 12 Saterlee Place in the Village of Wappingers.*
- Monday Night Miracles (Keith R). Meeting is strong and the business meeting is also. We have a newcomer taking over the coffee commitment. And, usual, we have the best chairs in Ulster County.
- New Beginnings (Derricks). Acting GSR for this group. We meet Saturdays 10AM-11:30AM at 161 Mansion Street. The meeting is starting to grow. After the accident at Salvation Army, attendance dropped but it's starting to grow again. We have 15-20 people at the meetings but I am the only one at the business meeting. I'll stick it out.
- A Set of Principles (Said A.). Grateful to be back at Area. This is a literature based group, meeting on Sunday at 1PM. Good attendance with 10-12 people and 8 in the business meetings. Growing, very informational.
- Living Proof (John B & Derricks). Fridays at 6:30PM, 12-15 attendees, rotating format. We are working on a group policy now, using the Men Do Recovery group's policy.
- Mission to Recovery (Barbara Marie). No GSR for this group yet. Sundays 7PM at 209 Fair Street, reopened 4 weeks ago, slow start with 9 attendees being the most so far. Format will change to literature based, reading stories from the Basic Text. This meeting is wheelchair accessible (has an elevator). It's orderly.
- Come As You Are (Kelly B). Everything is going well with this group, 5 home group members, open discussion meeting. Kelly celebrates 25 years on 2/27/24!
- God Shaped Hole (Lynn B.). We meet Saturdays at 10AM. \$10 donation to area. Average 12-14 attendees each week, business meetings have 6. She's acting GSR for now. We are having a Speaker Jam on 3/30/24 from 12-6 PM and we have a flyer here. We are asking each Group to suggest a speaker for the Jam. It'll take place at 209 Fair Street. Food and water will be sold to raise money for the Group Anniversary Celebration to take place this summer. Upcoming celebrations include Tara with 5 years on 3/23/24, Lynn with 30 years on 3/30/24 and Denise with 27 years on 4/6/24.

Barbara Marie shared – I often run into people who have time in this process but they have been misinformed regarding the service structure. Area is at the bottom, the groups are the main participants. It starts with the groups. Said added that he's grateful for Area and opportunities for growth. He said supporting area is important and he believes in what we do here. Kelly added that she has one home group. She said the concept talks about the group, how they are governed. She has kept her home group open for years by herself, not wanting to let it close. Every group needs trusted servants. She is learning to back off from a lot of things, but always shows up for her group. Trying to teach newcomers to take

over and help. Derricks thanked Barbara Marie for her share. He was thinking that the area came first, then the groups but he realized he was wrong.
